The Show

The Theatre have now cancelled our May dates so please remove those from your diaries.

I have made the decision to change our traditional show to a show movie this year. It will allow our students to finally perform their dances that they have worked so hard on and we will make the most out of this film experience to ensure they get the thrill they usually do from a show. I am hoping (restriction depending) we are able to organise a school outdoor cinema where students can all watch the movie premiere together!

Each dance will be filmed either on stage or in a specific location to match the story of their dance and will be put together into a movie that the students can watch and enjoy.

It will also be a perfect end to the virtual year of learning and hopefully create a special memory of such a different time in our lives.

Students will be working on these in class and then towards the end of June when the restrictions ease, I will begin filming, I will send out any information that requires students to attend a different location for their dance so you can plan ahead.

Costumes will still be required to get the full affect for our show movie so I will reissue the shows costume letters for those outstanding over the Easter break.

There will be a small fee to take part in the show movie to help towards the cost of the videographer, the hired venues and some of the effects I have planned. The ticket sales from our shows usually help to fund the show going ahead however tickets will not be needed. The school will be covering the main bulk of expense to put this on for the students and I will be doing most of this in my own time as a thank you for all of your support over the last year.

Each student's show fee will be £10, this will hopefully be a big saving on what is usually spent on tickets for our Gordon Craig show.

- * A new student registration form will be given out this term in class, please can these be filled in at home and returned to your teacher as soon as possible to ensure I have up to date details, consents needed for the upcoming show and to familiarise yourself with our school terms and conditions.

I'm sure you can appreciate as with all other businesses at the moment there are additional expenses to the school to operate in this new way.
